WALDPARK & REISSINSEL

Long walks in the parkland, a paradise for birdwatchers, dinner on stilts over the water in the “blue hour” of twilight, and all that in Mannheim? But of course!

The extensive “Waldpark” is located directly on the Rhine adjacent to the Rhine terraces and the “Stephanienufer” waterfront, and is criss-crossed by many paths and hiking routes. Here, you will discover meadow landscapes, waterways and abundant greenery to enjoy on a long, pleasant stroll. The park flows directly into one of the most significant river-meadow protected areas on the Upper Rhine, the “Reißinsel”. Together, the two areas provide living space for many domestic plants and rare animals, which you can discover and admire on your stroll.



INFO

For reasons of nature protection, the “Reißinsel” is inaccessible every year during the nesting and breeding season from March to June inclusive.

2 MANNHEIM IS IMPRESSIVE

Mannheim, the vibrant city on the Rhine and Neckar rivers, is cosmopolitan, colourful and diverse: baroque and art nouveau architecture alongside fantastic parks, top-class culture and festivals as well as a shopping and gastronomy paradise that is unique in the southwest.

Do you know why Mannheim is known as a grid city? This is due to the special street system in the city centre. Instead of names of famous people, you will find your way around using a combination of letters and numbers that designate the individual blocks in the city centre.



WASSERTURM AND FRIEDRICHSPLATZ

Mannheim was once known as “Little Paris”, and anyone who comes to the historic water tower will see why.

The greatest love of everyone from Mannheim? Definitely the historic water tower “Wasserturm”. This distinctive landmark stands impressively at the heart of one of the most beautiful Art Nouveau complexes in Europe, directly on “Friedrichsplatz” square. No wonder that it is taken as the backdrop for many wedding and holiday photos. It stands romantic and dreamy in the picturesque complex – with the water fountains, the historic lighting, the strolling paths and the arcades, it is a popular meeting place for both residents and visitors. An absolute must for your visit: a photo with Mannheim’s most famous landmark! In the evenings, the

PARADEPLATZ

This spacious square lies at the heart of the city centre.

Ten paths in a star formation lead to its centre, to the historic Grupello fountain. The green areas and surrounding benches encourage you to take a little break, so you can watch the busy world go by and get a direct sense of the city's busy activity. For instance, you could use this moment to take a little refreshment and to enjoy a coffee, an ice cream or some pastries from the neighbouring cafés.

MARKTPLATZ

On market days lots of inhabitants and guests meet on the market square.

The Baroque backdrop for the weekly market, which takes place three times a week, is the combination of the old town hall and the parish church of St Sebastian – incidentally, the oldest building in Mannheim.

BAROCKSCHLOSS MANNHEIM

Discover the Electoral Mannheim with a visit to the second largest Baroque palace in Europe: Mannheim Baroque Palace.

Amid the busy student life of the University of Mannheim, which is housed in the Baroque Palace, the “Schlossmuseum” (palace museum) invites you, with its historic interior as an integral work of art of the highest European quality, on a journey through time. The meticulously restored staterooms with over 800 exhibits bear witness to the style and customs of former times and will whisk you away for a moment into the life of the Electoral Court.



BY THE WAY

Even though Mannheim Palace is “only” the second largest baroque palace in Europe, it is the leader in terms of the number of windows: exactly one more window than Versailles Palace.

MARCHIVUM

This is where Mannheim’s fascinating history is preserved and secured for the future. Explore the city’s past up close in Mannheim’s largest above-ground bunker.

The former Ochsenpferchbunker in the Neckarstadt-West neighbourhood catches the eye from afar. The MARCHIVUM is not only a place dedicated to the preservation of municipal history, but also simultaneously a research centre, event venue and exhibition space that sees itself as an open space for encountering, experiencing, learning and researching.

REISS-ENGELHORN-MUSEEN

In the heart of Mannheim's squares, the four buildings of the Reiss-Engelhorn Museums (rem for short) form a museum quarter of their own with far-reaching appeal.

Experience exciting cultural history in one of Europe's most important museums, whose foundation stone was laid in the 18th century by Elector Carl Theodor. Whether early human history, ancient Egypt, antiquity, the Middle Ages, Mannheim's two "golden ages", photography or natural sciences - the many special exhibitions and collection presentations offer fascinating insights into the past, present and future for all ages.

KUNSTHALLE MANNHEIM

The Kunsthalle Mannheim is one of the most important museums of classical modernism and contemporary art. Its profile is marked by key works of painting from Édouard Manet to Francis Bacon as well as an outstanding collection of sculpture from modernism to contemporary art.

From 22 November 2024 to 9 March 2025, the Kunsthalle will be showing the exhibition "Die Neue Sachlichkeit - ein Jahrhundert-jubiläum". It is extremely rare to characterise an entire epoch with a single term. However, the young Mannheim Kunsthalle director Gustav F. Hartlaub succeeded in doing just that with his legendary "New Objectivity" exhibition in 1925. One hundred years later, the Kunsthalle Mannheim is dedicating a major exhibition to the "New Objectivity" phenomenon, which not only honours the achievements of the time, but also critically questions and complements them, especially with regard to the work of female artists, as not a single woman was represented in the 1925 exhibition.

It’s all possible at the Mannheim Planetarium!**

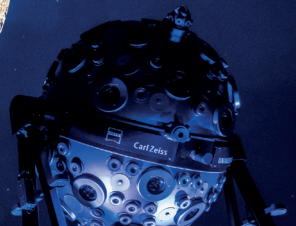

CHURCHES IN MANNHEIM

As a lover of sacred architecture, a truly huge variety is waiting for you in Mannheim!

There are 89 houses of God from various eras in the city. Come and visit churches, mosques and the synagogue. Apart from the “Jesuitenkirche” and the “Christuskirche”, which are probably the most famous examples in Mannheim, you can also discover small chapels, huge, splendid buildings and modern architecture and immerse yourself in the peaceful quietness of these special places.



BY THE WAY

The chapel “Magdalenenkapelle” in the district of Straßenheim, with sections dating back to the 13th century, is regarded as the oldest chapel within the boundaries of Mannheim.

JESUITENKIRCHE

This is one of the most impressive buildings in Mannheim and is located in the immediate vicinity of the Baroque Palace.

The former court church features an impressive exterior and boasts an equally splendid interior. As you enter the church, your breath will surely be taken away as the interior of this catholic parish church is simply so magnificent. The interior designed by Paul Egell and Peter Anton von Verschaffelt, among others, is rich in Baroque works of art such as the high altar and the ceiling fresco.

CHRISTUSKIRCHE

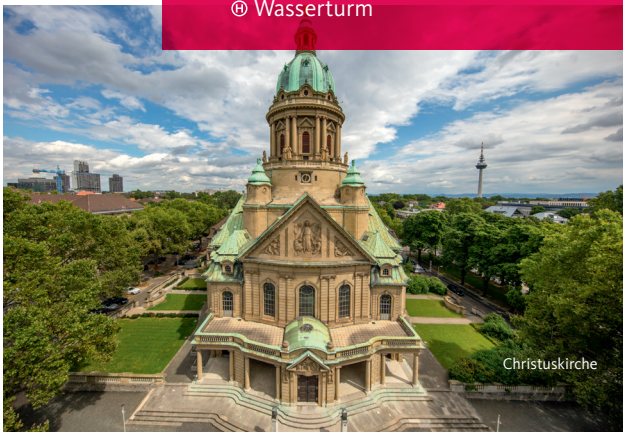
The Protestant church “Christuskirche” features an imposing, tower-shaped dome and a curved, Baroque floor plan.

With its splendid, neo-Baroque exterior, it blends beautifully with the surrounding villa quarter in the city’s eastern district – the Protestant church completed in 1911 is one of the most striking in the city. You will find several impressive elements in the interior: the northern gallery houses one of the largest organs in Germany, the Steinmeyer organ dating back to 1911.

The assorted small and individual establishments also attract international artists of various genres and will enchant you with a very special flair within historic walls.

NATIONALTHEATER MANNHEIM AND JUNGES NTM

Tradition and modernity, opera, theatre, dance and also a National Youth Theatre united under a single roof.

Thrilling stage productions all over Mannheim: the National Theater Mannheim (NTM) is one of the largest and oldest municipal repertory theatres in Germany. Even Schiller and Mozart left their mark on this storied institution, which stages award-winning theatre productions, numerous world premières and German premières across its four artistic divisions – opera, drama, dance and youth theatre. The main building is currently closed for a complete refurbishment, but exciting new interim stages have sprung up like the old cinema in Franklin.

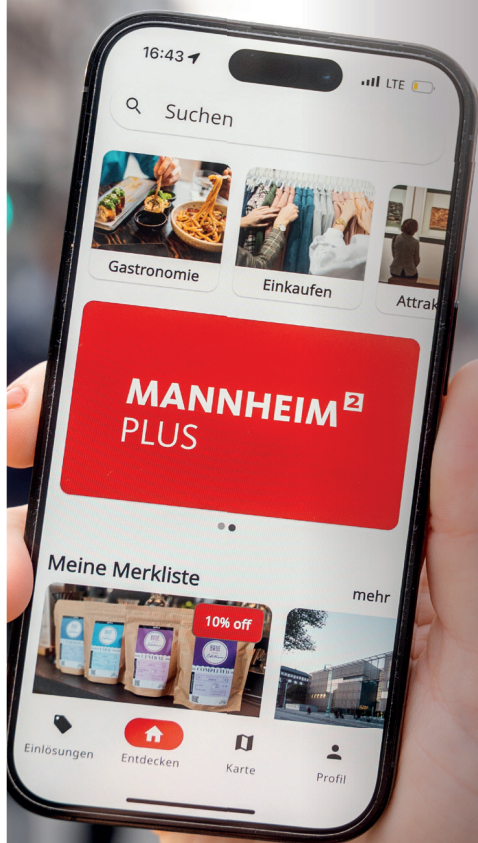

BY TRAIN

Mannheim Central Station

- All platforms are wheelchair-accessible
- Platforms with train destination displays or dynamic LED displays and speaker systems or dynamic LED displays with an acoustic module
- Tactile paving and guide strips for the visually impaired
- Wheelchair-accessible travel centre with information desk and entry through automatic doors
- rail & fresh WC provides toilet facilities at the station for people with disabilities. They can be used for free with a euro-key.

BY BUS & TRAM

The vehicles operated by Rhein-Neckar-Verkehr GmbH (rnv) are equipped for accessibility and deploy both visual and acoustic information systems.

Most tram stops are accessible, with tactile paving and either level access or wheel chair access via ramp. Many bus stops are also equipped for accessibility. Tram stops have dynamic passenger information displays, and this is supplemented by acoustic announcements at some stops.

EXCURSIONS BY BIKE

Neckartal-Radweg und Rheinradweg

Past palaces and castles, past forests, meadows and slopes covered with vineyards, industrial monuments and architectural gems, the Neckar flows through the heart of Baden-Wuerttemberg. Always by its side: the cycle route “Neckartal-Radweg” that lets you enjoy a close-up experience of this varied landscape. There is also the option of a tour from Mannheim to Heidelberg, joining the two residence cities of the Electoral Palatine. The Rhine Cycle Route accompanies one of the most important rivers in Europe over a length of 1,233 km: the Rhine. Enjoy the beauty of the river landscape – perhaps with a cycle tour from Mannheim through the forest area “Waldpark”, to Lampertheim, Speyer or Schwetzingen. Depending on your chosen destination, you will ride through forests, cross dams and weirs and pass through clearings and meadows. A 3 km long section of the express cycle path between Mannheim and Viernheim was built on the site of the former National Garden Show and is currently being extended and connected to other express cycle paths.

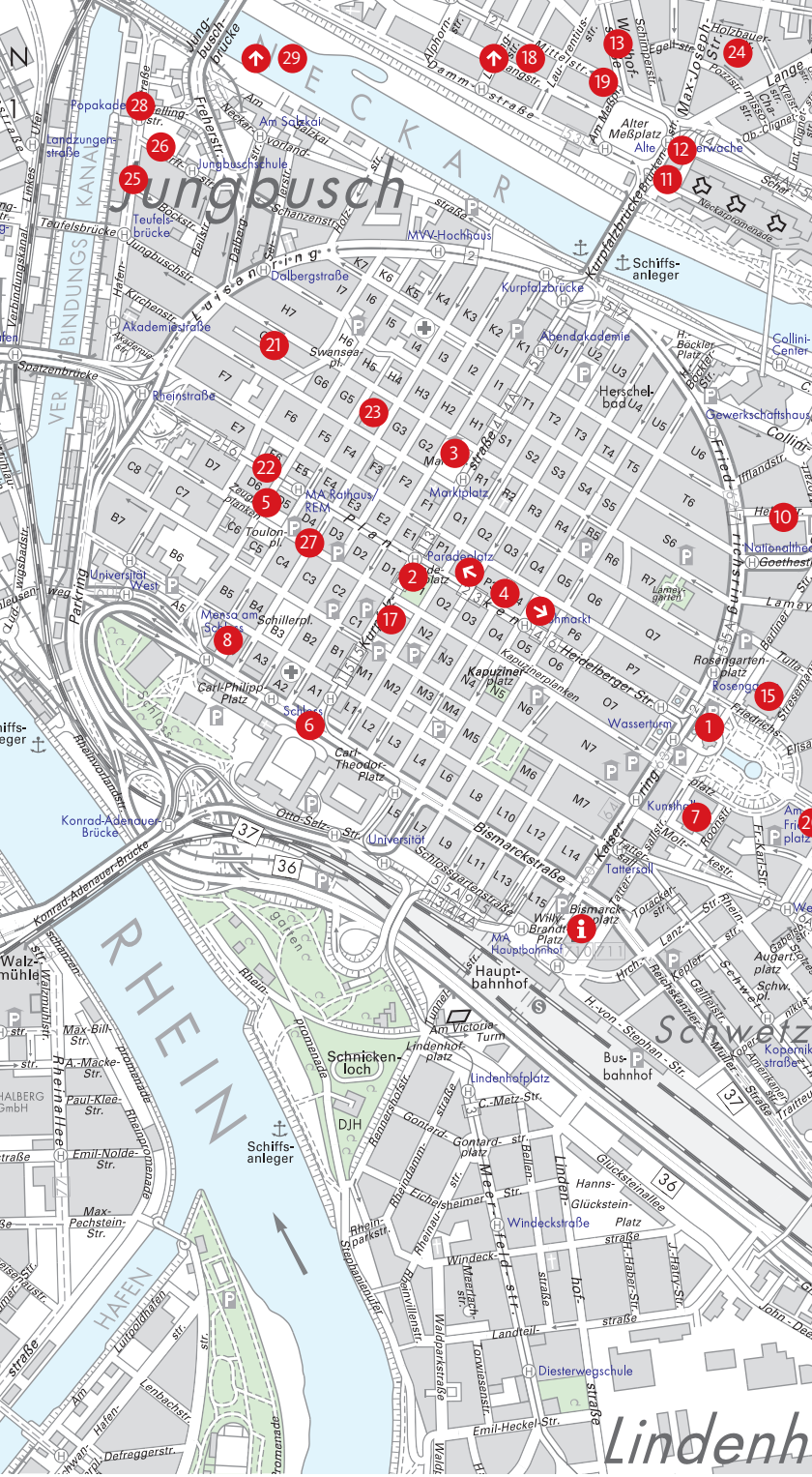
